17. I, or we, do hereby agree and obligate the recipient of any retail beer permit issued pursuant to this applicant, under full penalty of the law, to the following terms and conditions:

(1) That alcoholic beverage containing more than 4% alcohol by weight will not be sold, kept, stored or secreted in or on the premises for purpose of sale in areas that have voted to legalize the sale of such alcoholic beverages, unless a license has been secured from the State of Mississippi to sell such alcoholic beverages.

(2) That beer or wine will not be sold or given to be consumed in or upon any licensed premises between the hours of midnight and seven o'clock the following morning or during any time the licensed premises may be required to be

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closed by municipal ordinance or order of the Board of Aldermen, except, however, in areas where the sale of alcoholic beverages is legal under the provisions of the local Alcoholic Beverage Control Law and the hours for selling such alcoholic beverages have been extended beyond midnight for on-premises permits under Section 67-1-37, the hours of selling light wines or beer are likewise extended in areas where the sale of beer or light wines is legal.

- (3) That beer will not be sold, furnished, or given to any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years, or to any person noticeably intoxicated, or to any insane person, or to any habitual drunkard.
- (4) That lewd, immoral, or improper entertainment, conduct or practice, will not be permitted on the premises.
- (5) That loud, boisterous, or disorderly conduct, or loud musical instruments will not be permitted or conducted on the premises, and nothing will be done to disturb the peace and quietude of the community wherein such business is located.
- (6) Those persons of ill repute, known criminals, prostitutes, or minors, except minors accompanied by parents or guardians, or under proper supervision, will not be permitted on the premises.
- (7) That gambling or operation of games of chance will be permitted on the premises.
- (8) That any of the laws of the State of Mississippi or ordinances of the City of Eupora will not be violated by the applicant, or that the applicant will not knowingly allow any person to violate the laws of the State of Mississippi or ordinances of the City of Eupora while in or on the premises.
- (9) That all invoices covering purchases of beer for sale upon the premises will be carefully preserved for inspection, and that all rules and regulations promulgated by the State Tax Commission or the Board of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Eupora, Mississippi, under provisions of the law will be complied within the operation of the business for which the permit is procured.

All of the foregoing representations apply individually and collectively to all offices, directors, and the person or persons managing the licensed premises of any corporation and to any such stockholder of such corporation owning more than 5% of the stock of such corporation making application for this permit.
